




#### Empowered Men Of Color, Men's Conference! November, 2018 Tag: Achievement Week










## Memorial Service March 2019









#### We Must Keep Going 2019 Tag: NAACP Life Membership








#### Room In the Inn Ministries December, 2018 Tag: Other Social Action; Health Initiatives






# Omega Men Perform February Tag: Other Social Action
